



South Carolina United FC Competitive Soccer Financial Obligations

There are several components to the financial commitment to play Competitive Soccer with South Carolina United FC.

Once a player has accepted his/her position the parents of the player are responsible for the required fees set forth below, even if the player does not play the entire Fall and/or Spring seasons. A player will not be granted a release from SCUFC until all required fees are paid in full and the player is in good standing with the club.

<p>Evaluation Fee <i>(Required)</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • This fee must be paid before a player can be evaluated for a competitive team. • Paid directly to the club online at www.southcarolinaunitedfc.com via credit or debit card.
<p>CLUB FEES <i>(Required-paid in Demosphere)</i></p> <p>Paid directly to the club online in Demosphere via credit or debit card at www.southcarolinaunitedfc.com</p> <p>Payment plans are available and selected at registration.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Club fees include league fees, referee fees, state cup fees, training fees, goalkeeping training, administrative expenses, maintenance expenses, insurance expense, and other overhead expenses necessary to operate and maintain the organization. The current Club Fee chart can be found on our website at www.southcarolinaunitedfc.com. • Failure to pay club fees can result in player suspension. <p>Financial Assistance</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Financial Aid is available for Club Fees <u>only</u> (does NOT apply to Team Fees) on a needs-based basis to the extent that there are funds available. • Please click the Financial Assistance link to complete the application. The financial aid application is a separate program option during the online registration process. • Grants will be awarded after candidate completes the interview with the Financial Aid Committee.
<p>Registration/ Participation Fee <i>(Required)</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • This is the standard registration fee that all members pay to participate in our programs. • Paid directly to the club online when accepting team position. • This fee is non-refundable after accepting your team position online.
<p>Capital Improvement Fee <i>(Required)</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • This fee goes toward improvements to existing club-owned facilities. • Paid directly to the club online when accepting team position. Sibling discounts apply.
<p>Volunteer Opt Out Fee <i>(Optional in lieu of working required volunteer hours)</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Each family is required to volunteer 5 hours <u>per registered player per season</u>. • Any player's parents who choose to opt-out of working these hours can pay the \$75 per registered player per season Volunteer Opt Out Fee (\$75 per Fall only player; \$150 per Fall/Spring player) • Paid directly to the club online when accepting team position. • Fees for unworked hours will be billed to the player's account at the end of the season.
<p>TEAM FEES <i>(Required – paid in TeamSnap)</i></p> <p>Invoiced and collected via online credit or debit card or ACH payment in TeamSnap</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Team Fees are the player's portion of the team budget for the team to operate for that season. Each team/pool has a budget that is calculated based on that team/pool's league travel schedule and tournament/event schedule • This Team Fee budget includes the following expenses for the team/pool: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Tournament/event entry fees ○ Coach's travel expense for tournaments (hotel, per diem and mileage) ○ League game travel expenses (games outside of greater Columbia/Lexington) ○ TeamSnap annual fee ○ Miscellaneous fee (for unexpected team expenses or additional travel costs) • All players are responsible for paying the <u>full Team Fee budgeted amount</u>. If a player cannot attend a tournament or game, he/she is still responsible for the associated costs. • Failure to pay Team Fees can result in player suspension. • Team Fees are non-refundable.
<p>Uniform Kit Fee <i>(Required for ALL PLAYERS for the 2022-24 season)</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Every player is responsible for purchasing a SCUFC PUMA uniform kit during the active 2-year uniform kit cycle (current cycle is 2022-2024). The kit includes 3 game jerseys, 3 game shorts (2 black and 1 red), 3 game pairs of socks (1 red, 1 blue, 1 black), 2 short-sleeve practice jerseys and 1 quarter zip jacket. New to club players are also required to order the Team Backpack. Goalie kit includes 3 game jerseys, 2 black shorts, and 2 pairs of black socks. • Ordered and paid directly to Lloyd's Soccer through MyUniform link that is emailed to you after team acceptance/payment.
