



## South Carolina United FC New Player Procedure

The following procedure must be followed regarding any new player trying out or attempting to play for South Carolina United FC:

- Initial contact must be made with one of our Directors of Soccer and/or Club Registrar.
- Once contact (phone, email, or fax) has been made with a Director of Soccer, he will notify the Head Coach of the team the player will be evaluated for.
- The player **MUST** register online for the Select Tryouts and/or Academy Evaluations and pay the \$25 **BEFORE** he/she attends a tryout session and/or practice. This is for liability reasons. No player may be invited to a practice and/or scrimmage without first registering with South Carolina United and agreeing to our Parental Liability Waiver.
- The Head Coach will organize a specific date and time when he or she will evaluate (tryout) that player.
- A player must attend a minimum of two evaluations before the decision is made. After the evaluation the coach will then decide whether or not he/she is going to select the player.
- The coach **MUST** notify a Director of Soccer and contact the player and the player's parents within a maximum of 10 days regardless of the decision.
- The Directors of Soccer will determine which level a player will be evaluated first. New players will normally be evaluated by the Head Coach of an Elite team first and then referred to the Head Coach of a Palmetto/Crescent team if not selected and an age appropriate team is available.
- **The Club Registrar – must be contacted immediately upon player selection!**
- **PLEASE ALLOW ONE WEEK TO TEN DAYS FOR APPLICATION TO PROCESSED.** (SCYSA registration).
