



Referee Uniform Requirements

(10/2007)

All referees are expected to adhere to the following:

- All Matches are to be refereed according to the FIFA Laws of the game. These laws may change based on the special age group requirements in some instances.
- Arrive at match at least 15 minutes ahead of time. From time to time this may not be possible due to refereeing back to back matches and will be overlooked for this reason only.
- A proper uniform, equipment, and decorum are required at all times while in uniform or while refereeing a match. The uniform requirements apply to all referees. This also includes Assistant Referees during a match.
- A proper uniform includes:
 - At least one of the approved uniform tops (Yellow, Red, Black, or Blue). All referees on duty should match.
 - Referee shorts/pants. Not soccer pant or Sophie's.
 - Referee socks. Three stripe black.
 - Hats may only be SOLID BLACK. No logo hats. No other colors.
 - 2 whistles (Not for AR's during a match).
 - Match record card properly filled out prior to match.
 - Wrist watch, preferably two.
 - Flags.
- Assistant referees are expected to be keeping the proper time as well as a current score card through out any match they are working. This is not for the convenience of the fans and coaches to ask you questions. This is for the center should anything happen to their equipment during a match.
- While in uniform, shirts will be tucked in and socks will be pulled up.
- Remember, this is a job and you are being paid for it. Do not disgrace your profession.
